TECHNICAL EXPERTISE IN BUSINESS

We need professionals who can act as business trainers and consultants to deliver ongoing technical support in fields such as marketing and finance to our project beneficiaries, to assist them whilst they face numerous challenges through their entrepreneurial journey. We also need experienced entrepreneurs who can act as mentors for help to develop these newly started businesses.

ACCESS EXPORT MARKETS

Rural businesses often have products that can be exported, however, they often do not have the knowledge and skills needed in this field and have difficulty finding global markets. Support in accessing export markets and learning the procedures and requirements would be of tremendous help for rural young entrepreneurs.

TECHNICAL EXPERTISE IN IT | REMOTE IT JOBS

JMF works to equip people to find employment in the IT sector, due to the growing demand in the labor market. We are in need of experts who can deliver IT trainings and on-job coaching to young people with potential. Meanwhile, as IT jobs are limited in the remote regions, due to scarce number of IT firms operating there, creating remote IT employment opportunities for our graduates will assist them in remaining in their town, not moving to Yerevan or migrate abroad in search of work.
